

Roundup of other VA Benefits:

Q: What are some other VA benefits that I may not know?

A: Most veterans know about the basic healthcare and education benefits available to them through VA, but there are some other ancillary benefits programs.

AID AND ATTENDANCE, long-term care is expressive but often necessary to provide care for aging relatives. Through the Aid and Attendance program, many veterans are eligible to receive money to cover the cost of long-term care options. Should you choose to take care of an ailing veteran at home, VA offers a caregiver support program.

Burial Benefits, when a veteran dies, families may request a U.S. flag to drape over the casket and a certificate to honor the deceased loved one's service. VA also provides a free headstone or grave marker.

GI bill, in addition to receiving credits to use toward a college degree, the GI bill offers up to \$2,000 to help cover the cost of certification courses or other vocational training programs. Unused credits may be transferred to spouses and dependents, although there are service limits required to transfer the benefits.
